HOW TO INSTALL "COOKIES"

Cookies ("cookies") are small packets of data that are saved by your browser when you visit our websites, including the

- smartwphosting.io
- my.smartwphosting.io

websites (hereinafter referred to as "our websites"). Cookies are generally used by websites to improve the user experience by either "remembering" the user for the duration of the visit during repeated visits ("persistent" cookies) or cookies, which are deleted when the browser is closed ("session" cookies).

Cookies are not used to store information that directly identifies you. However, please note that in some countries, data such as cookie identifiers or IP/MAC addresses are considered personal data. Where we process data that is personal data, we will always handle in accordance with our Privacy Policy.

OUR WEBSITES USE THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF COOKIES

On our websites, the user may encounter the following:

- absolutely necessary cookies;
- cookies that store user preferences (functional cookies);
- cookies that collect statistical data (performance-related)
- community site with cookies.

The use of cookies, which are strictly necessary for the operation of the website, does not require the user's specific consent, because without the management of these cookies the website would not function.

ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY COOKIES
